

## Let Freedom Ring: Community Gathers to Honor our Liberty Bell

As the nation celebrates its 250th anniversary this Independence Day, Members and a guest can touch, feel – and ring – a physical reminder of how their fellow residents in the past paid tribute to their country during the country's bicentennial celebration in 1976.

The Sun City Liberty Bell, located at the Recreation Centers of Sun City™ Bell Center, stands as a tribute to the citizens of the past and their commitment to both their country and community.

The community's annual "Ring That Bell" Ceremony, held on July 4, 2026, takes on greater significance this year because it serves as a reminder of the national celebration that took place 50 years ago.

### History of the Liberty Bell

The 2,080-pound bell was unveiled before a crowd of 4,000 residents at a ceremony held July 4, 1976, at Sun Bowl Shopping Center. Residents lined up for a chance to ring the bell, launching a community tradition that has continued ever since on Independence Day.

The Sun City Liberty Bell later that year was installed at its permanent location in Memorial Garden at Bell Recreation Center. A dedication ceremony was held Nov. 15, 1976, chosen because it also marked the 199th anniversary of the nation's adoption of the Articles of Confederation, the nation's first Constitution.

### Opening the Time Capsule

A time capsule was sealed and placed in the base of the bell with instructions to open in 2026, the nation's 250th anniversary. The time capsule contained several items, including letters from Sun City residents written especially to future residents.

The Del Webb Sun Cities Museum and the Recreation Centers of Sun City, will conduct a ceremony this year to officially open the time capsule.

The ceremony is planned for Sunday, November 15, 2026 from 1:00 to 3:30 p.m. in the Sundial Center Auditorium. The museum will be replacing the 1976-time capsule with a new time capsule to be sealed in the base, not to be opened until 2076.

# Planning Responsibly for RCSC's Future

## Understanding the Factors Impacting RCSC's Budget

Planning responsibly for the future of the Recreation Centers of Sun City (RCSC) requires understanding the factors that impact the organization's ability to maintain its facilities, programs, services, and Member experience.

As part of the 5-Year Planning process, representatives from all RCSC committees reviewed operating and capital forecasts to better understand future needs and challenges. The team's work focused specifically on RCSC operations and facilities and provided a comprehensive look at the resources needed to continue supporting the amenities and experiences Members value.

Like many organizations, RCSC continues to experience increases in operational costs. Several key areas are impacting future budgeting considerations, including utilities, employee medical benefits, insurance, risk management, and ongoing facility maintenance.

Utility costs are one example of an area experiencing continued increases. Changes in rates from providers such as Arizona Public Service (APS), EPCOR, and Southwest Gas impact the cost of operating RCSC facilities.

RCSC is also taking intentional steps to reduce risk through proactive actions, programs, and processes designed to keep Members and employees safe while supporting long-term sustainability. These efforts are also intended to help lower insurance costs over time by reducing risk exposure.

Responsible financial planning is about balancing today's needs with tomorrow's priorities. The goal is to continue providing the high-quality facilities, programs, and services that contribute to the active lifestyle and Member experience that make RCSC a valued part of Sun City.

The 5-Year Planning Team has completed its review, and recommendations will continue through RCSC's established budget process. The Budget, Finance and Audit Committee will review the recommendations and provide a final recommendation to the Board of Directors for consideration.

No final 2027 assessment amount has been approved at this time. The Board of Directors will ultimately review and vote on the proposed budget and any related assessment recommendations.

RCSC remains committed to keeping Members informed throughout this process and sharing updates as additional information becomes available.
