Aqua Fitness Club



Do you need some exercise and love the water? Ready to have a great time with new friends? Then joining the **Aqua Fitness Club** is for you! **The routines are done in waist to chest deep water performed with music and verbal instruction from qualified instructors for 50 minutes of low impact**

stretching, aerobic, and strengthening routines. Stretch and tone classes are available for those with limited mobility or those who prefer a non-aerobic type of class.

Water aerobics improve aerobic capacity, muscle endurance, and overall quality of life. The water provides a stable environment for anyone with less balance control, therefore preventing injuries.

Classes are held at different times of the day at Marinette, Mountain View, Oakmont and Sundial (indoor) center pools.

Year-round classes are held twice a week in heated pools, Monday and Thursday or Tuesday and Friday. The club offers five sessions a year with each holding sixteen classes per session.

All Sun City Members in good standing are welcome to join. Membership is \$5 per year. Classes are \$15 a session. Members, 90 years of age or older, receive yearly free membership and one free class per session. 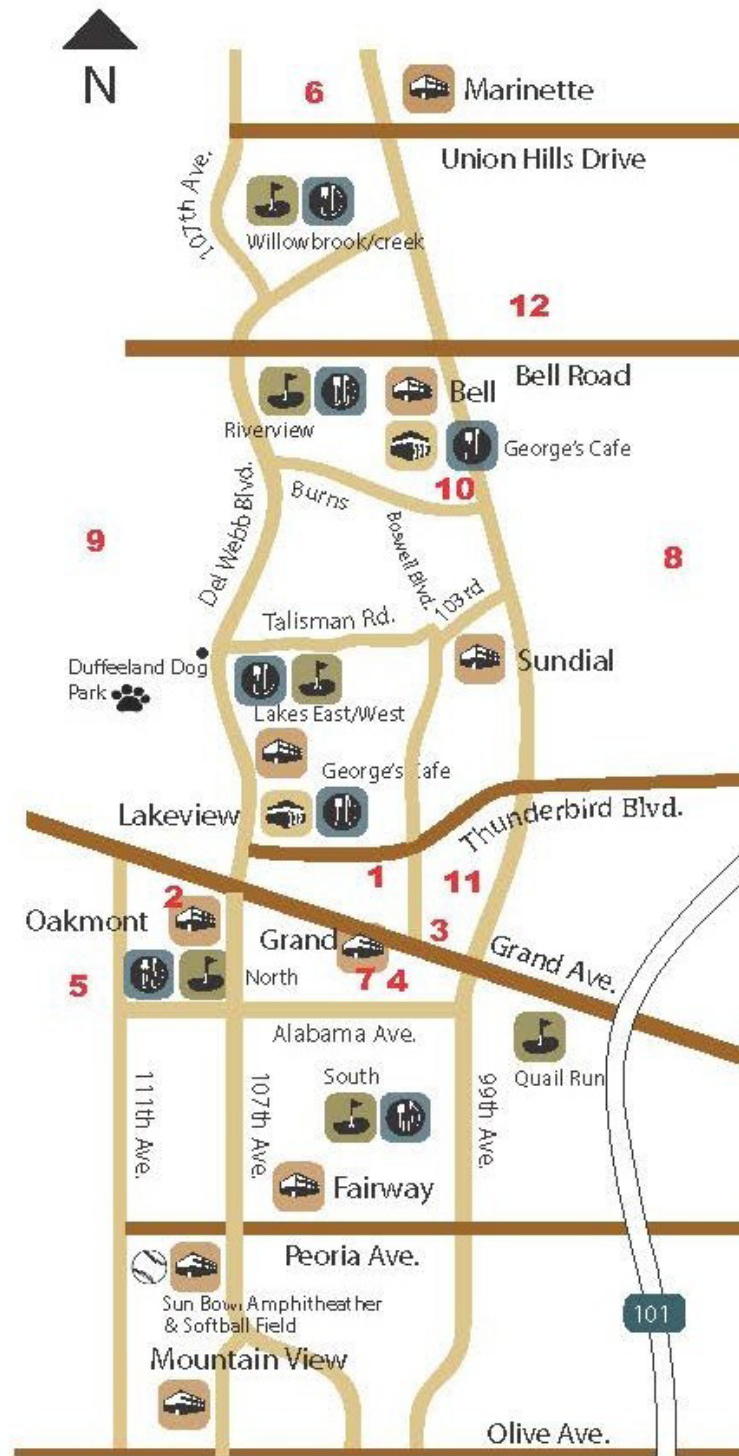
