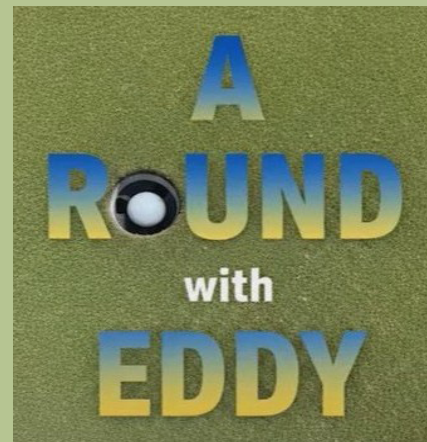

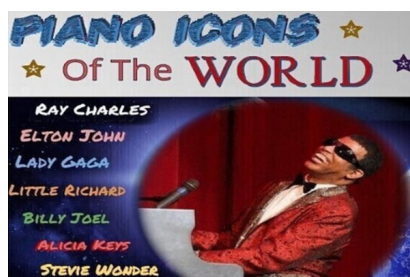

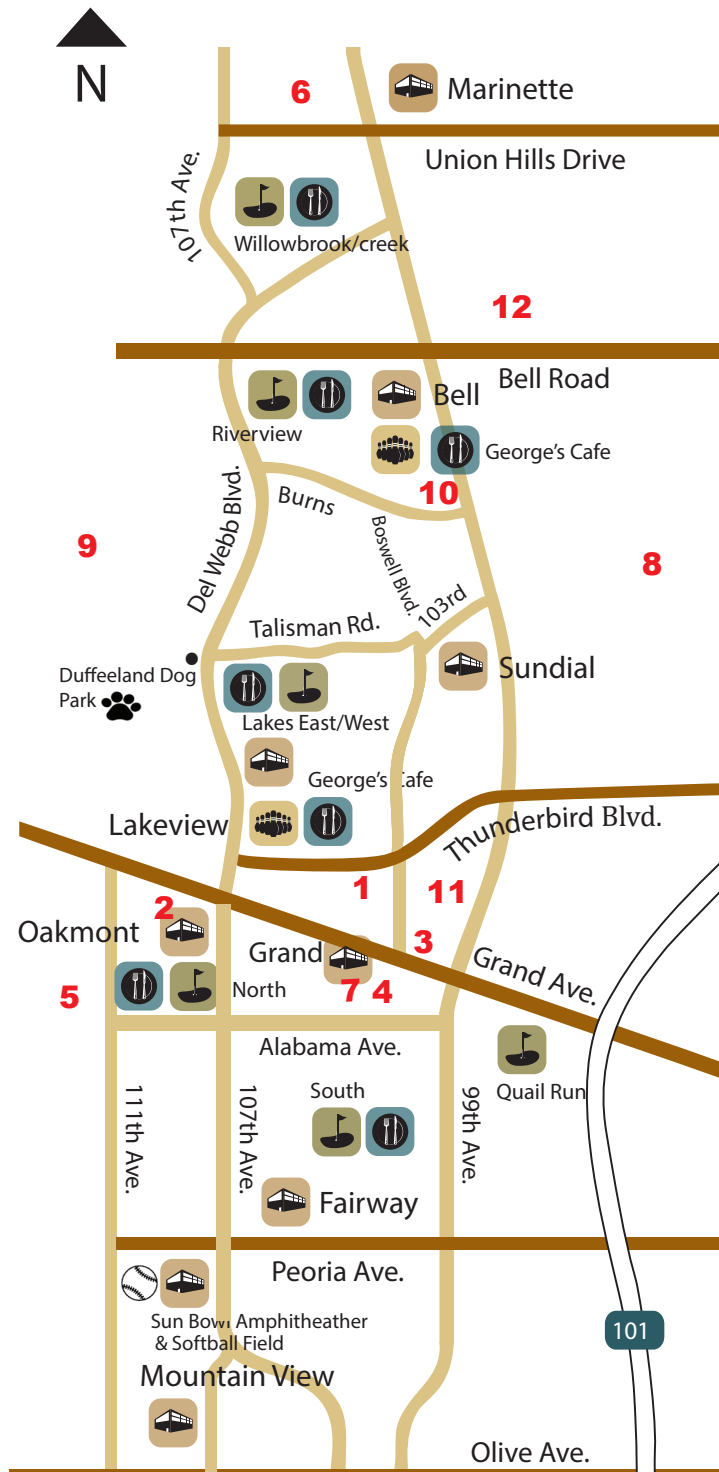

Mountain View Center Renovation Update

Town Hall held on January 13, 2026, to discuss Member-driven Option 3

Did you know the **Mountain View Recreation Center** was the third center built in Sun City by Del E. Webb? Some Members describe it as a hidden gem enjoyed by many over the past 50+ years. Fast forward to today and RCSC is making excellent progress of the strategic evaluation, planning, analysis, and community outreach to renovate this historic center. In tandem with triARC Architecture and Design, we have completed the following:

- triARC Visioning Phase
- triARC Programming Phase
- Executed and Signed full Design contract
- Research and Analysis of Option 3 Permutations Delivered (Community Outreach phase)

The guiding principles of this project include: 1) Fiscal responsibility, 2) Preserving existing amenities, 3) Renovation and modernization, 4) Sustainability and maintainability, 5) Inclusivity and accessibility, 6) Efficiency and effectiveness, and 7) Quality of life and enjoyment.

Based on data from the Community Outreach phase, with a focus on the above-mentioned guiding principles, the RCSC Board voted to move forward with Member-driven "Option 3." On January 13, 2026, RCSC held a Mountain View Tall Hall meeting and invited triARC to present an update on this project and discuss specific elements of Option 3, including a breakdown of two "permutations" or sub-options. There was also dedicated discussion for specific seating options for the renovated Performing Arts Center (PAC).

RCSC, in collaboration with triARC, will continue to communicate our progress. **A full recording of the Mountain View Town Hall can be found on our YouTube channel here: <https://www.youtube.com/@suncityaz7348>.** We look forward to the future completion of the Mountain View Center renovation that our community can be proud of and enjoy for many years to come.
